MISSIONARY PRAYER FOCUS

Global Partners is asking for focused prayer this week for Andrea Swarthout, missionary to Japan.

Andrea grew up in a Wesleyan pastor's family and became a Christian very early in life. At age 12, she felt God leading her into full-time missions. The next year she knew God was calling her to Japan and giving her a love for the Japanese people.

She earned a B.S. degree from Oklahoma Wesleyan University in intercultural ministries and an M.A. in biblical studies from Asbury Theological Seminary. In 2004, she became an ordained pastor in The Wesleyan Church.

Andrea began her missionary service with Global Partners in 2005. Her passion is to assist the Japanese church in becoming a dynamic influence & a thriving witness for Christ in their culture.

Prayer Points from Andrea Swarthout:

- Pray for the new strategy currently being implemented on the Japanese field, which means updating our legal registration with the Japanese government—an extensive undertaking. Pray for God's leading and favor with the government.
- Pray for me as I start a cafe ministry alongside a local Immanuel church. Pray as I take each step, that God would provide the funding. I am thankful to belong to a network of Japanese missionaries already involved in this type of ministry, and I am taking advantage of our monthly video conferences.
- Pray for the Japanese church. Protestant Christianity represents only 0.5% of the 127 million Japanese population. Pray that God would raise up new pastors and missionaries to Japan.
- Pray for the spiritual strongholds in Japan to be broken down.
- Pray for our partnerships in Japan. As Global Partners missionaries, we partner alongside a Japanese denomination called Immanuel General Mission, as well as World Gospel Mission. We also belong to the Japan Evangelical Missionary Association. Pray for unity and increased collaboration.


