## **GLOBAL PRAYER-NET**

### **MISSIONARY PRAYER FOCUS**

This week's prayer focus is on Global Partners missionaries living among the Fotizo people. The Fotizo field is part of the Turkic-Arabic area of Global Partners. Since security is an issue, the names of missionaries and locations are omitted. We are highlighting the Fotizo team's work on the field instead of focusing on individual missionaries.

The Fotizo team consists of five missionary family units (10 adults, 9 children). The team is focused on making disciples and multiplying churches in a country of over 80 million people that is 99% Muslim.

The Fotizo people have experienced a shrinking economy and growth in political tensions over the past two years. However, during this time, people have been growing in spiritual hunger. Throughout our network of like-minded believers, we have seen a number of Bible study groups develop. The Global Partners Fotizo team has also seen some new groups start with the DNA of forming churches that will multiply.

### **Prayer Points from the Fotizo People Missionary Team:**

- Pray for opportunities to proclaim the truth of who Jesus was and is to those we encounter at parks and cafes and in our daily activities.
- Pray for the Lord to reveal himself to those who are focused on "being religious" during the Muslim holiday of Ramadan (May 6-June 3). Pray that Jesus would be seen as the way, the truth, and the life.
- Pray that God would be drawing groups of people to himself.
- Pray for Bible study groups to continue to grow into churches.
- Pray for the intern students coming this summer to work with the Global Partners NEXT program. Join the Fotizo team as we pray for each intern as they step away from their familiar and engage in a new culture. Pray for them to grow in understanding of global ministry and personal faith.
- Pray that Fotizo believers would crave scripture and grow in their faith.

**1. MARY MAGDALENE FELT HOPELESS**

**2. THOMAS FELT HOPELESS**

*“That Sunday evening the disciples were meeting behind locked doors because they were afraid of the Jewish leaders. Suddenly, Jesus was standing there among them! ‘Peace be with you,’ he said. 
