MISSIONARY PRAYER FOCUS

Global Partners is asking for focused prayer this week for Mindy Loew, missionary to Mongolia.

At the age 15, Mindy knew that God was calling her to full-time ministry, and by 19 it became clear that God was calling her to cross-cultural service. In her pursuit of missionary service, she obtained a bachelor of ministry degree, majoring in global ministry from Kingswood University in 2015. After serving the local church in outreach for three years in western New York, God led her to Mongolia. She's passionate about seeing the unreached and unengaged changed by the gospel. In Mongolia, she teaches English as a platform to share the gospel.

Mindy lives her life to make Habakkuk 2:14 (NLT) a reality:
"For as the waters fill the sea, the earth will be filled with an awareness of the glory of the Lord."

Prayer Points from Mindy Loew:

- This summer we have two short-term teams visiting. Pray that our missionary team will get all of the details arranged here in Mongolia, and pray for wisdom in preparation.
- Every member of our missionary team has had struggles with obtaining visas. Pray that God would give us favor and provide us with safe and legal ways to remain here.
- Because we have all had changes in our visas, we all have had changes in our jobs as well. Pray that God would give us strength and wisdom to navigate changes in responsibilities.
- Learning the Mongolian language is difficult. Pray that God would give me ears to understand the Mongolian language and the ability to recall vocabulary when speaking to my friends.
- Mongolians tend to be wary of foreigners and are very private people. Pray for continued opened doors into relationships with Mongolians and give me favor in building trust.
- Pray for my future. Pray that God would direct my life very clearly, and pray that I would be brave enough to follow him.
