- Pray that we clearly communicate our ministry to churches and individuals so they see the need for the caring of missionaries.
- Partnership development requires a great deal of travel as we visit churches near and far. Pray for safety in our travels.
- During partnership development, it is necessary for us to decrease the amount of time we spend working with the missionaries assigned to our care. Pray for God to give us wisdom on how to care for these missionaries during this time.
- REquip is a week of training for Global Partners missionaries that takes place at the end of each missionary's term. It's a time for missionaries to debrief their service, celebrate their effectiveness and share needs. Pray for our time at REquip at the end of June as we participate and facilitate this training.
