GLOBAL PRAYER-NET

MISSIONARY PRAYER FOCUS

Global Partners is asking for focused prayer this week for our missionaries living among the Nune people. Security is an issue in this Muslim country, so missionaries' names have been omitted.

"Mohammad is the last prophet!" my taxi driver stated. I had just been trying to engage him in conversation about the prophets Abraham, Isaac, and Jacob. Muslims also believe in these prophets, but I could see this conversation wasn't going much further. This man is part of the Nune people group—an unreached Muslim people group in Central Asia. I knew he was devout—he fasted during Ramadan and brings his son to the Islamic prayer times. He is like many in this city who are experiencing a revival of Islam. They are becoming more diligent about obeying the rules, but they are merely following what they are being told to do. I believe he was not able to discuss the prophets with me because he really doesn't know about them. Few Nune people in this area actually read the Qu'ran. They rely on the local religious leaders to tell them what to believe.

Prayer Points from Our Missionaries to the Nune People:

- We believe that a revival in Islam means that there are people who are earnestly seeking God. That is good news! Pray for God to connect us with these people. We trust that when people seek God with their whole hearts, they will find him.
- Pray against the lies that Islam teaches—that Jesus is not God, that Christians believe in three gods, and that the Bible has been corrupted. Pray that the social pressure to adhere to Islam would be overcome by genuine hunger to learn Jesus' truth.
- In our city, the Nune people are the minority people group. Our team decided that we would also intentionally reach out to the majority people group. Pray for wisdom as our team seeks the best way to reach out to each of these people groups.
- Our team members must have a "platform" in order to live in this country. In other words, we need to have jobs besides what we do with Global Partners. This can be challenging with changes in the laws of the country, corrupt governments, and the time and stress involved in doing our local jobs. Pray that God gives us wisdom regarding what kinds of local jobs to do or create. Pray that our jobs would facilitate the Kingdom's work.
