MISSIONARY PRAYER FOCUS

Global Partners is asking for focused prayer this week for Jim and Lori Rice, missionaries to Ecuador.

Jim and Lori started to sense God's call to global missions while taking part in numerous short-term trips to Latin America. After a fact-finding trip in 2010, God's call was made clear. Jim and Lori knew Ecuador was where they were to go. They first moved to Costa Rica for language school in 2011, and they have lived in Guayaquil, Ecuador, since 2013.

Jim and Lori minister in their community while giving support, encouragement, and leadership to the Ecuadorian pastors, churches, and Global Partners missionary team. Lori leads neighborhood Bible studies and ESL classes in their home. Jim serves as the Mission Director and Missionary Team Leader for the Ibero-America Area. Their vision is to see the Church in Ecuador grow into a movement of disciples making disciples, fulfilling the Great Commandment & the Great Commission.

Prayer Points from Jim and Lori Rice:

- The Wesleyan Church of Ecuador will have its first mission camp on August 22-28. Pray that the pastors, mission director, and mission council would work in unity, partnering with The Wesleyan Churches of Colombia and Peru.
- Pray for the national church to obtain government approval for their incorporating documents called the Personaría Jurídica, which will give our churches legal standing.
- Pray for this coming year's Leadership Development Program. Pray for Jim, national pastors and missionary Isaac Thompson, who will meet to review this year's program.
- Pray for The Wesleyan Church of Ecuador as they work toward local/national/regional autonomy. The Ibero-America Established Regional Conference through three regional directors and a regional board will take over leadership from Global Partners/The Wesleyan Church of NA in December 2019. Pray for unity, consistency, clarity, and communication.
