MISSIONARY PRAYER FOCUS

Global Partners is asking for focused prayer this week for Daniel and Deanna Stanley, missionaries to Haiti.

Daniel went on his first short-term mission trip to Haiti in 2009. He immediately fell in love with the country and the people. He carried that excitement home with him and shared it with Deanna. Over the next eight years, they both returned regularly to Haiti for short-term trips where they developed a burden for the many needs there.

In 2016, they felt called to go and serve as long-term missionaries to Haiti. They are excited to be used in whatever ways God needs them. Daniel and Deanna have three children: Zoe ('98), Isaac ('00), and Gavin ('07).

Prayer Points from Daniel and Deanna:

- Pray for our two children at Southern Wesleyan University. Zoe just started her senior year and Isaac started his sophomore year. Pray for Deanna and Gavin. Deanna will be homeschooling Gavin for his 7th grade year—a first for them.
- Pray for us as we continue to learn Creole.
- Pray for safety as we continue to travel to the island of La Gonave several times a month.
- Pray for our staff and the relationships we are building. Pray that we can show God's love to the people here.
- Pray for Haiti. Pray that things remain calm. There has been a gas and diesel shortage this week. Pray for quick resolution.

Luke 7:36-50

Jesus Anointed by a Sinful Woman

³⁶Now one of the Pharisees invited Jesus to have dinner with him, so he went to the Pharisee's house and reclined at the table. ³⁷When a woman who had lived a sinful life in that town learned that Jesus was eating at the Pharisee's house, she brought an alabaster jar of perfume, ³⁸and as she stood behind him at his feet weeping, she began to wet his feet with her tears. Then she wiped them with her hair, kissed them and poured perfume on them. ³⁹When the Pharisee who had invited him saw this, he said to himself, "If this man were a prophet, he would know who is touching him and what kind of woman she is—that she is a sinner." ⁴⁰Jesus answered him, "Simon, I have something to tell you." "Tell me, teacher," he said.

⁴¹"Two men owed money to a certain moneylender. One owed him five hundred denarii, and the other fifty. ⁴²Neither of them had the money to pay him back, so he canceled the debts of both. Now which of them will love him more?" ⁴³Simon replied, "I suppose the one who had the bigger debt canceled." "You have judged correctly," Jesus said.

⁴⁴Then he turned toward the woman and said to Simon, "Do you see this woman? I came into your house. You did not give me any water for my feet, but she wet my feet with her tears and wiped them with her hair. ⁴⁵You did not give me a kiss, but this woman, from the time I entered, has not stopped kissing my feet. ⁴⁶You did not put oil on my head, but she has poured perfume on my feet. ⁴⁷Therefore, I tell you, her many sins have been forgiven—for she loved much. But he who has been forgiven little loves little." ⁴⁸Then Jesus said to her, "Your sins are forgiven."

⁴⁹The other guests began to say among themselves, "Who is this who even forgives sins?" ⁵⁰Jesus said to the woman, "Your faith has saved you; go in peace."
