MISSIONARY PRAYER FOCUS

Global Partners is asking for focused prayer this week for Phil and Kristy Boardman, missionaries to the Czech Republic.

Phil and Kristy each had a gradual, but clear, call to overseas missions. They both served in the Czech Republic when they were single as GO-Net volunteer missionaries with Global Partners before God called them back as long-term missionaries.

Serving in the Czech Republic, they desire to be a light in a darkened city through teaching English and working with the local church. Their vision is to see Czech Christians in Brno reaching out to nonbelievers. Phil and Kristy have one child: Oliver ('16).

Prayer Points from Phil and Kristy Boardman:

- Pray for Oliver as he continues to adjust to the Czech Republic and preschool. He attends preschool 3 mornings/week.
- Pray that we our residence permits would be renewed without any complications. We applied for the renewals on September 10 and are waiting to be accepted. The process usually takes at least three months. We also need to move, but we must wait on our permits. Housing is getting more expensive and limited. When the time comes, pray that the Lord would lead us to the right apartment.
- Pray for wisdom for our Czech Wesleyan church and pastor.
- Pray for the weekly Conversation Cub and Bible group on Tuesday evenings. Pray that God's good news would fall upon hearts made soft by the Spirit.
- In our new season of life with a toddler, pray that we would have deeper connections with families through our church, children's classes, Oliver's preschool, and Conversation Club.
