MISSIONARY PRAYER FOCUS

Global Partners is asking for focused prayer this week for Cory and Jennifer Ellison, missionaries to Mongolia.

Jennifer and Cory have been doing ministry together since they got married in 2003. Jennifer loves using her Th.M. (Master of Theology) to help people find healing and wholeness in relationship with God. Cory is a ministry coach and people developer. He gets excited helping people become more successful in whatever God has called them to. Since 2016 they have been working with the leaders of the Mongolian Wesleyan Church to create a ministerial development process to more effectively train pastors. In their free time, with their daughter, LeYanna ('10), they like reading, learning new things, creating art & exploring.

Prayer Points from Cory and Jennifer Ellison:

- Pray for us to remember our vocab, think in Mongolian structures, and take opportunities to practice speaking.
- Pray for wisdom regarding the possibility of buying a business from a retiring missionary. Would provide stable visas for at least two Global Partners families, income for the church, and jobs for at-risk people...but it's expensive.
- Pray for continued favor with the Mongolian Wesleyan Church and its leaders.
- Pray that we'd discern God's priorities for our family and our ministry. Pray that we wouldn't get distracted by the good things that aren't ours to do in this season.
- Pray for the health of our family: that Cory's treatment for trigeminal neuralgia would continue to be effective, that LeYanna's limp from her fractured ankle would heal, and that we'd avoid the worst of the flu season.

The SOAP Bible Journaling Method



BIBLE READING CHALLENGE

Every Wesleyan church in Canada is being encouraged to participate in a national Bible reading and journaling challenge, beginning Monday, January 6, and ending on Good Friday, April 10, 2020.

There are selected, sequential readings from the New Testament over 70 days. The readings/journaling take place Monday through Friday, which allows some 'catch-up' time on the weekends for any days you may miss reading/journaling during the weekdays.

The journals consist of 4 short entries, using the acrostic S.O.A.P.

S - write out the favourite **Scripture** verse you read that day.
O - a general **observation** about what the Bible verse means.
A - an **application** of the Scripture to your life or situation.
P - a one or two sentence **prayer** for the day.
