MISSIONARY PRAYER FOCUS

- Global Partners is asking for focused prayer this week for Alex Brown, missionary to Cambodia.

After spending six months in Cambodia on a short-term trip with Global Partners, Alex gained a deep appreciation for the Khmer people and for sharing the love of Christ with them. He is now following the call from God to be a long-term missionary. Alex foresees Cambodian youth being raised up to share the gospel in communities.

Prayer Points from Alex Brown:

- Pray for peace and confidence in partnership development and reaching out to potential supporters.
- Pray for proper time management as I balance working construction and partnership development full-time.
- Pray for the youth in Cambodia who I connected with during my six-month term. Specifically:
 - Nong: A very smart 16-year-old who desires to have a relationship with Christ. He comes from a Buddhist family.
 - Heng: One of the youth who I witnessed an incredible transformation in him. He is continuing to grow in Christ and attending church despite many of his friends not doing so.
 - Hong: He comes from a broken family, with a grandma who has abused him in the past for going to the church so much. He is continuing to learn what it means to truly follow Christ.
- Pray for the five youth who accepted Christ last month during our Wesleyan Youth Conference. Pray that they have continued to learn more about what this decision means. Pray that they are given confidence in Christ to not be afraid to tell others.
- Pray for our Wesleyan pastors in Cambodia who are reaching the lost in their communities
- Pray for the Holy Spirit's leading and direction as I connect with people about Cambodia and what God is doing there.
